

Funding agreement for project to support youth co-operatives

On Tuesday 17th July 2012 FIOM Rwanda successfully gained funding for a project to support youth through the development of co-operatives in the eastern province of Rwanda.

The project, which will be funded by NEPAD (the New Partnership For African Development) will see FIOM Rwanda work directly with 600 vulnerable people, 90% of whom will be women, to form cooperatives and to develop income-generating skills.

FIOM will also work closely with local authorities in the area to develop their capacity to provide a more enabling environment for cooperatives.
